

Funding for Erasmus+ Staff Exchange

Teaching (STA) and Training (STT) – Project 2023

The financial support for the mobility is based on the different costs of living in the destination countries and the distance to the destination. There is no legal entitlement to funding or a specific grant amount.

Subsistence costs

The following standardised daily rates apply for the country groups up to the 14th day of stay; from the 15th to the 60th day of stay, the subsidy amounts to 70 percent of the daily rate:

Group 4 [*]	Non-associated partner countries: Ghana (Accra), Kosovo (Pristina)	180 Euro / day

Travel expenses

The contribution to the travel expenses supplements the above-listed daily support. It depends on the distance between the place of departure and destination of the mobility and is calculated in a standardised way using the Erasmus+ <u>distance calculator</u>.
